

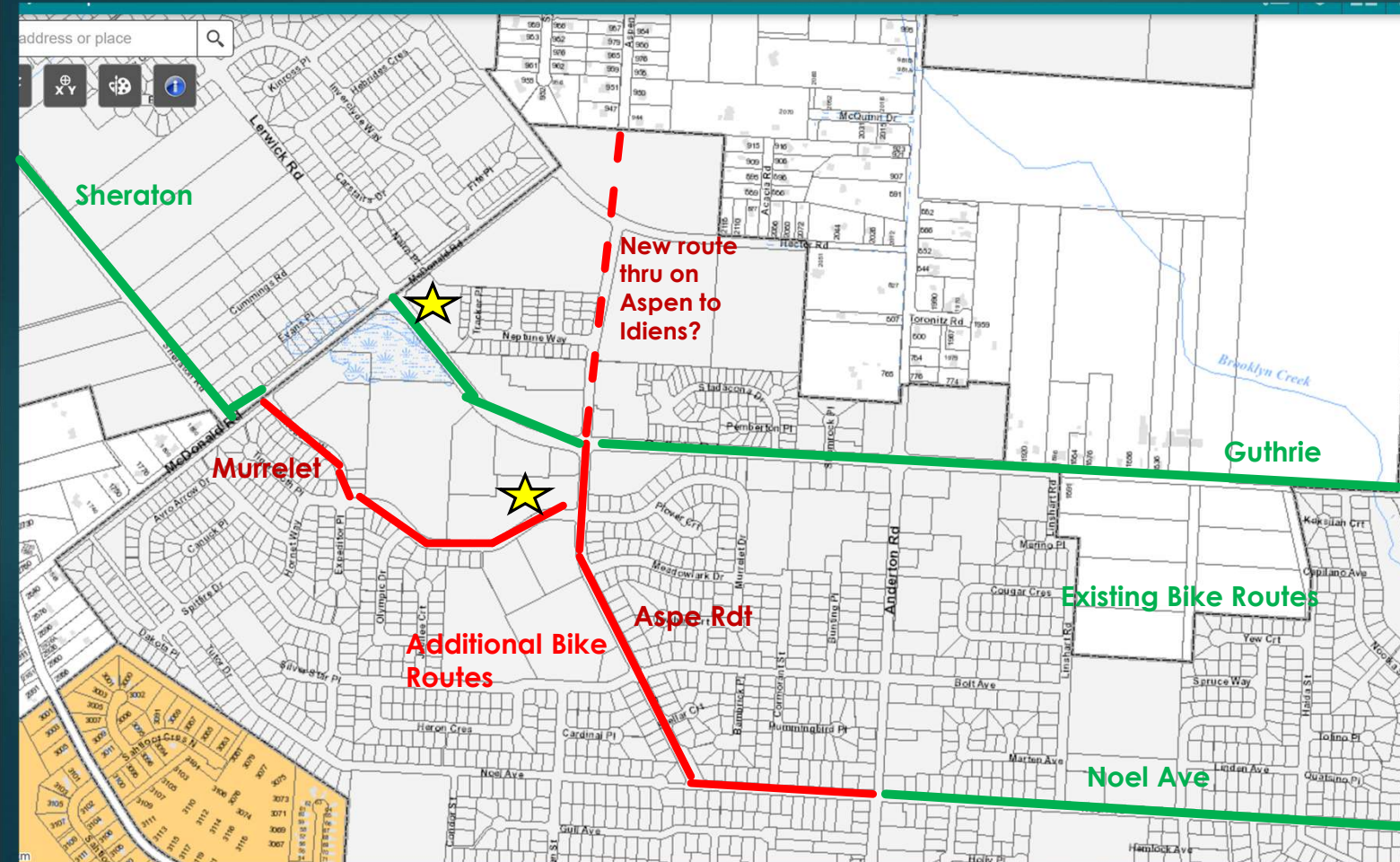

## Noel Ave/Aspen Rd Area



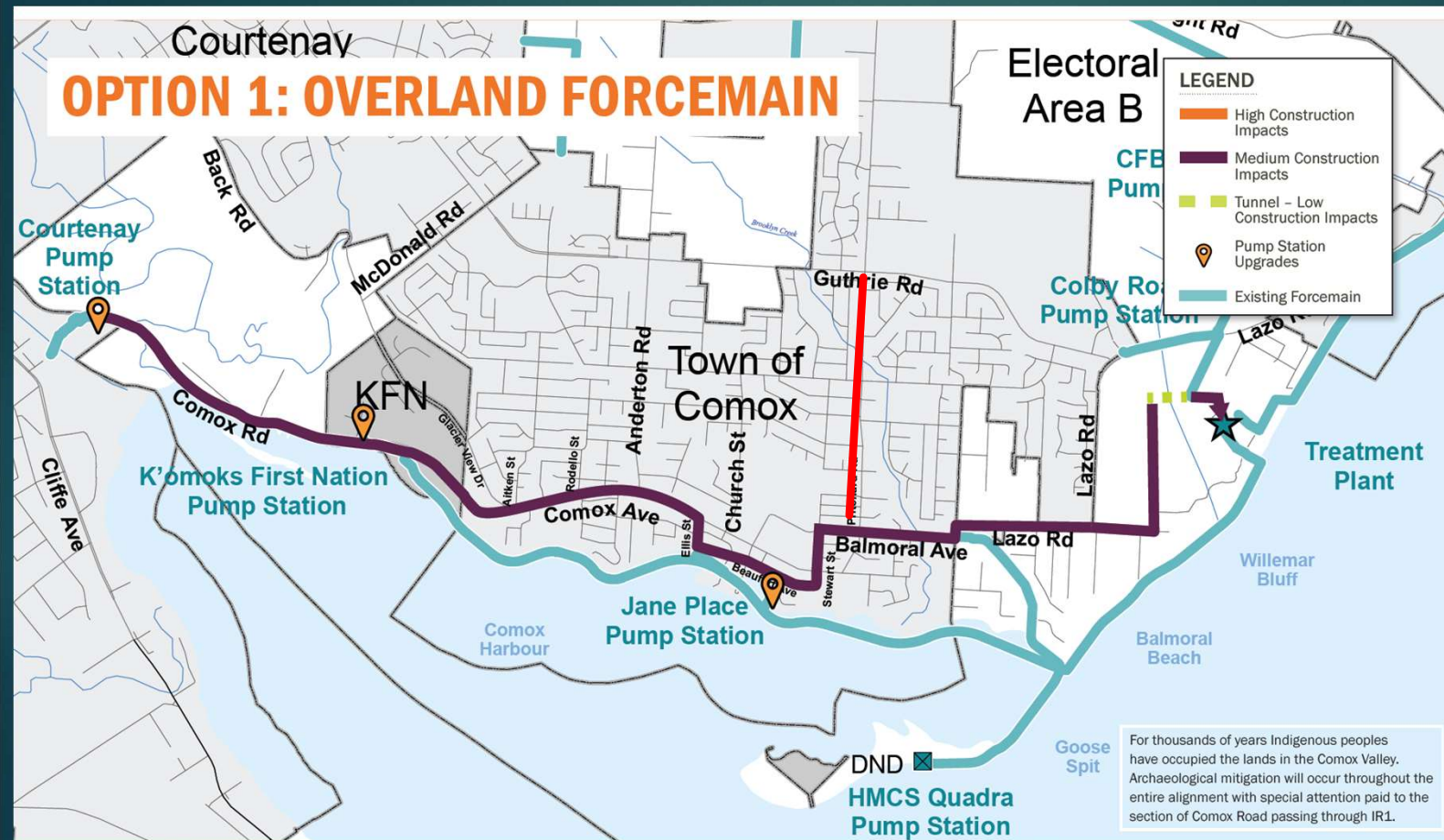
- Continue Bike Lanes on **Noel Ave** west of Anderton and north on **Aspen** to Guthrie (new north connection to Idiens?)
- Add bike lanes along **Murrelet** west to Lancaster to meet up with **Sheraton Greenway**
- These are key pieces to connect Comox to **Hospital/NIC, East Courtenay and Crown Isle**

★ High density housing developments



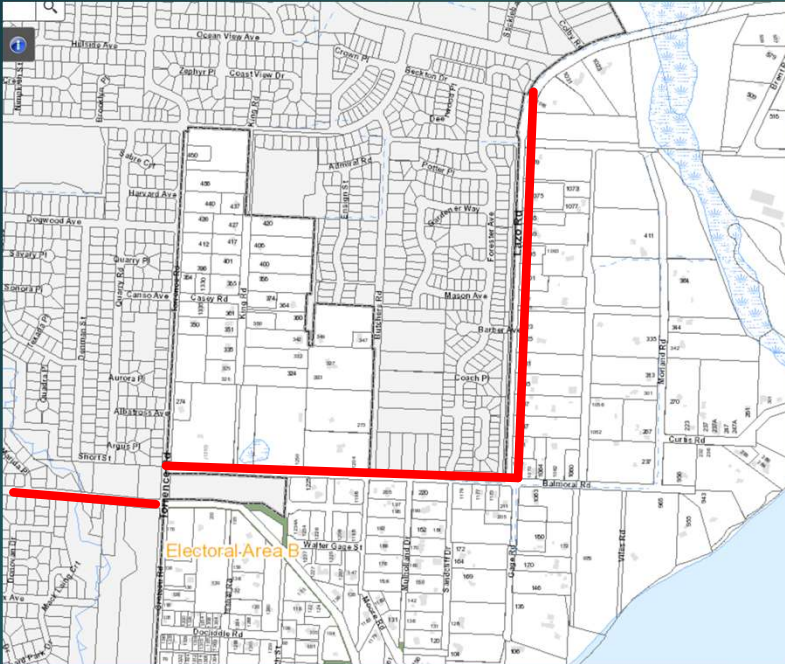
## Downtown and Waste Management Upgrades

### OPTION 1: OVERLAND FORCEMAIN



- Options being reviewed to upgrade liquid waste management – likely will result in **significant disturbance to roads**
- Great opportunity to **review** the E-W **cycling network** and cycling facilities in downtown Comox
- Extend Pritchard Bike Lane to downtown

## Lazo/Balmoral

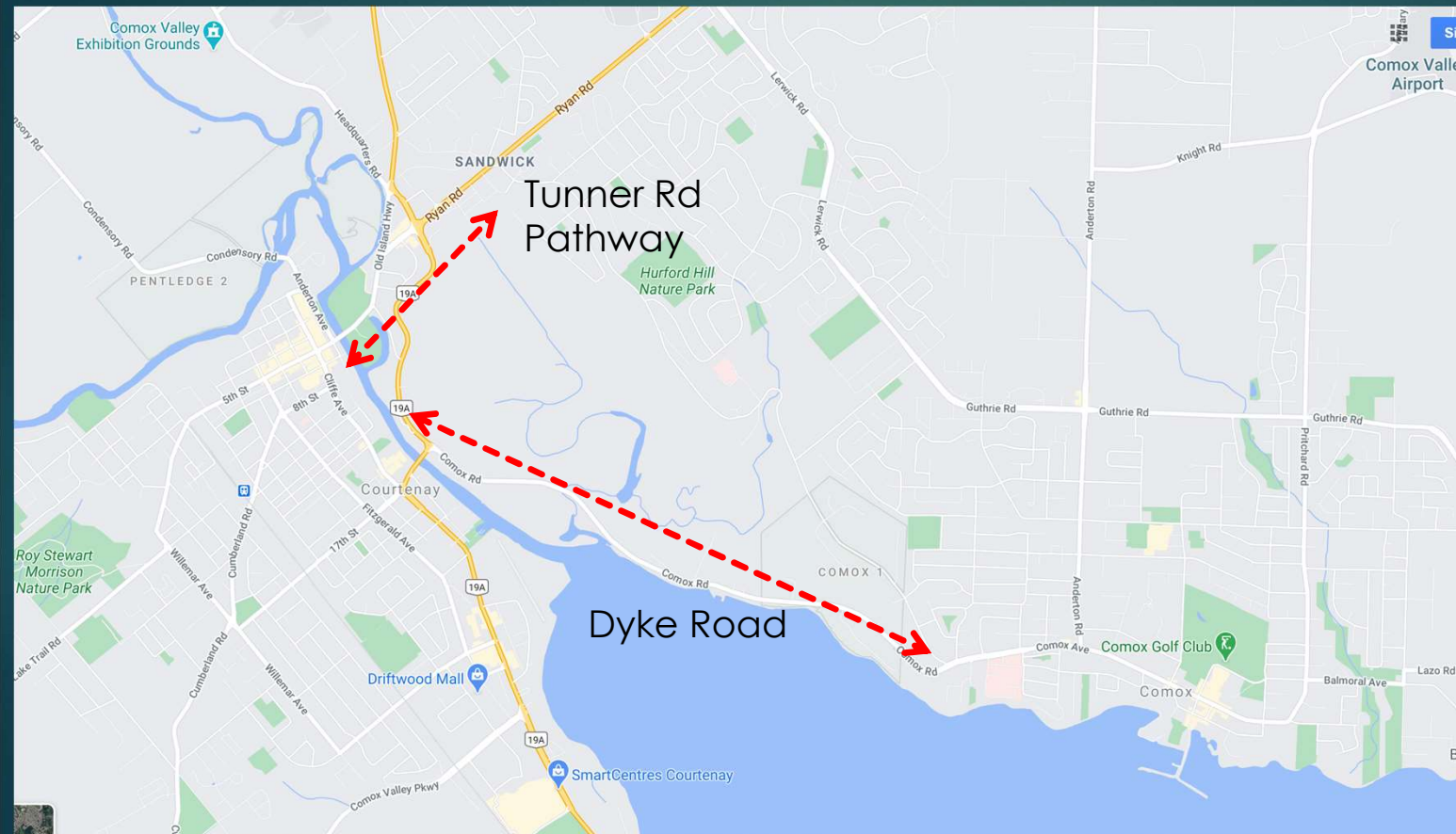


- Lazo (E-W) is likely to be along new sewer route and can be upgraded with bike lanes
- Lazo Rd (N-S) needs shoulder/bike lanes as well.
- Balmoral (Torrence to Pritchard) also needs consistent shoulders





# Comox Road



- MoTI working on an upgrade to “Dyke Road” – 19A Bypass
- Opportunity to improve cycling connectivity between Comox and Courtenay
- **Involves Comox, KFN, MoTI and Courtenay**
- Tunner Road pathway under review by City of Courtenay
