- **Events/Promotion**
 - Very successful summer with events at Filberg, Nautical Days, YANA and others! (Brian)
 - NIC orientation day on Sept 7, 11-1:30. Mike will attend and pick up table, banner and tent from Brian beforehand. Will keep gear until after Rexpo (CFB Comox Sept 9), Hope to spur interest in memberships and adult cycling courses.
 - EV Day at Marina Park Sept 24 (10-3). Will coordinate with Brian to get tent, table and a few bike racks. Focus on people there to see or try e-bikes.
- **Mapping Project**
 - Project Update provided by email. Ctte is engaging Lester Jones to start the update to the digital and print versions of the maps
 - OpenStreetMaps work will continue but priority is being given to route updates for CVCCo maps due to spending requirements of grants for 2023. Will finalize map legend and start feeding updates and edits to Lester asap.
 - Noted that our map is different from major centers such as Van due to fact we do not have the same level of infrastructure as yet and the “subjective” mapping of quiet streets or rural roads is key for our user base (at this time).
 - Ultimate goal is to have an OSM driven digital map.
 - We will be asking membership for assistance in editing maps to ensure we utilize that knowledge base.

- **Infrastructure**

- Lazo Rd work underway. Rotary interested in placing bike repair station at Point Holmes. Hope to organize a celebratory ride of Lazo when complete. Coordinate with Comox (Kerr/Minions).
- Courtenay – Neighbourhood Bikeway and Lanes on 1st/Puntledge School/Pidcock/Piercy
- Dingwall stairs installation starts this fall/winter
- Comox/CVRD sewer line project postponed until spring 2024. Section along Lazo to sewer plant now being ditched (was to be bored). Plan to ditch along southbound lane of Lazo Rd to Brent Rd. This will affect some of the new shoulder on Lazo between Guthrie and Simba.
- Lazo Greenway is being worked on separately for most part and should not be affected (waiting on MoTI permit at Guthrie?)
- CVRD has sent Royston Rd AT crossing of 19A for design
- Cumberland-Courtenay AT link – review, consultation and design planned for 2024 by CVRD
- Traffic light sensors – lots of interest and we have added instructions how to trigger in our adult course.

- **Other Business**

- Safety on Condensory Road just north of bridge has been brought to our attention (rough road, lack of shoulders combined with blind corner). Mike to contact KFN to try and initiate an active transportation dialogue, what do they see as issues and how can we help?
- Mike has been invited to a “Round Table” discussion organized by Gord Johns with Eleanor McMahon who is CEO of Trans Canada Trails. TCT will do a presentation on their current activities and available funding and we can have a conversation about bring TCT northward from Nanaimo on Island. Tentative date is Tuesday, Sept 12. Mike to provide further info as it becomes available.
